Democratic Representative Joaquin Castro said that during the rampage, Trump tweeted that Pence "didn't have the courage to do what should have been done." A video showed rioters spreading word of Trump's tweet to one another on bullhorns.

"He further incites the mob against his own vice president,

whose life was being threat-

ened," Castro said.

House managers prosecuting the case also said Trump did little to stop the violence as it spiralled out of control, despite pleas from many Republicans to ask his supporters to

They said he had planted the seeds for the riot by encouraging violence and making false claims the election was stolen long before Jan. 6.

"Trump realised last spring that he could lose the November election and began planting seeds of anger among his supporters by saying he could lose only if it was stolen," said

Representative Joseph Neguse. Several Republican senators said the security footage was emotional, but many added it did not change their

minds. "He bears some responsibility for what happened that day, but ... that doesn't mean that impeachment is the right way to address it," said Senator Marco Rubio.

Trump's lawyers will have 16 hours to deliver their side of the argument.

Sugar exports may drop on logistics issues: Trade body

FE BUREAU Pune, February 11

SUGAR EXPORTS ARE estimated to be lower in the 2020-21 season compared to the previous year. The All-India Sugar Trade Association (AISTA) has forecast a decline in exports in the 2020-21 season at around 43 lakh tonne. In the previous season, India exported around 59 lakh tonne.

The crop committee of the association, which has discussed estimates on sugar production for the current season, said exports are likely to be less than the last year due to the logistics constraints – shortage of containers and large movement of grains including soybean - leading to congestion at the ports and increase in the waiting time.

Praful Vithlani, chairman of the association, said chances of export of sugar to Iran are bleak as


the rupee balances in the Vostro accounts held by Iranian banks with UCO Bank and IDBI Bank have been nearly drawn down.

The committee has estimated production for the season at 299 lakh tonne.

The sugarcane crop was partially infected with the red rot disease in the parts of eastern UP and Bihar. The sugar production in this region is likely to be lower by about

Due to lower production of sugarcane, it is expected that all sugar factories in the area would close within February.

The estimates of sugar production of 299 lakh tonne are subject to $\pm 1/-2\%$ variation. The association has estimated that about 20 lakh tonne of sucrose would get diverted in the current sugar season due to production of ethanol from B Heavy molasses and sugarcane juice.
